Get Ready for the DTV Transition

On September 8, 2008, television channels broadcast from Wilmington, NC will turn off their analog signal. Channels 29 and 39 and stations in other parts of North and South Carolina will broadcast their analog signals.

If you have an analog television that is not hooked up to cable or satellite, or if you turn off your satellite to watch local channels, you MUST have a converter box to see the Wilmington channels in digital after September 8, 2008.

Get Ready Now.

Digital is already out there and you can watch it now. You **DO NOT** need a new TV. You **DO NOT** need Cable or Satellite. Your analog television will work with a converter box and a standard VHF/UHF antenna. If you already have a DTV, it will work without a box.

Get the FREE Coupons.

Call 1-888-DTV-2009 or go online at WWW.DTV2009.GOV and order up to two FREE \$40 coupons per household. The coupons give you a \$40 discount when you buy the converter box. You will not have any other costs unless you decide to upgrade your antenna.

Get the Converter Box.

Take your coupons to any place where you can buy electronic equipment. You will receive a list of retailers with your coupons.

Get Your Converter Box Hooked Up.

Follow the converter box instructions. Call your manufacturer if you have questions. Ask at the electronics store. If you still have problems, call 1-877-DTV-0908.
